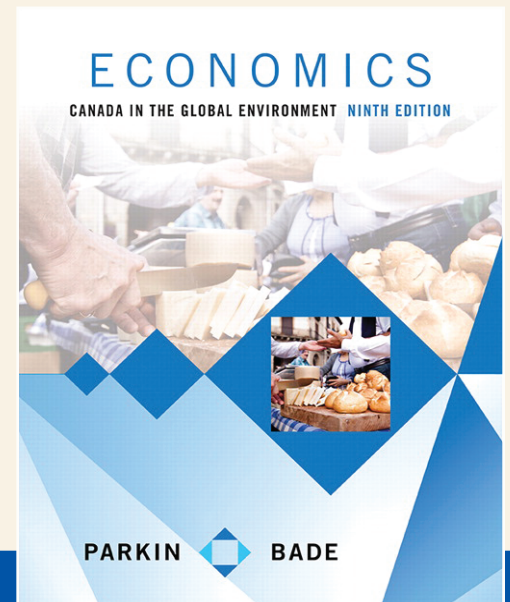

■ Economics in the News, a weekly feature on MyEconLab, features in the revised text in two ways. First, the Parkin-Bade hallmark chapter-closing feature, Reading Between the Lines, is rebranded as Economics in the News.
